Request for Holy Baptism

What is Baptism?

Baptism is initiation into the Christian church. It is a sacrament of the universal church. Through baptism we are re-born as children of God, and become inheritors of the promises which God has made to all who believe in Jesus Christ.

Who can be baptised?

Mature people who have not already been baptised who wish to become Christians, and the children of people who are already Christians.

Baptism of children

Children are baptised on the understanding that they will be brought up within the life of the church and that they will be taught by their parents what is means to be a Christian.

Children's Sponsors / Godparents

There are usually at least three godparents who share, with the parents, a commitment to the Christian upbringing of their godchild. Godparents must themselves be baptised; it is desirable, but not obligatory, that at least one of them should be a communicant Anglican.

Baptism of an adult

An adult usually has one or more Sponsors/Godparents.

Thank-offering

The grace of God is free. There are no fees for the Sacrament of Baptism. If family and friends wish to make an offering, it can handed to the Priest or Verger (in an envelope) after the service, or at a main Sunday service, put in the collection bag.

Referral

After the baptism, people who live outside the parish and do not regularly worship in the St John's congregation, will be commended to the priest of the parish where they live.
